

## Day 1 Tuesday, September 7 Home - Whitefish, Montana

Our tour begins at the train station in St. Cloud where we meet our traveling family for our exciting tour to the **Canadian Rockies**. Here we climb aboard and enjoy all the amenities of Amtrak's comfortable reclining seats, a spacious lounge car to enjoy socializing and cocktails, dining car, not to mention the panoramic views in relaxing comfort. Traveling along the Missouri River we pass by huge cattle ranches and Indian reservations heading deep into the **Rocky Mountains**. Approximate travel time is 21 hours. Following our 9:00 p.m. arrival into Whitefish, Montana we check into the Holiday Inn.



## Day 2 Wednesday, September 8 Glacier National Park - Waterton Lakes

Today we board our deluxe motorcoach and meet our local driver to see how geological processes have formed and sculptured more than 50 glaciers and mountains that tower 9,000 feet above 200 lakes which comprise this terrain. Entering **Glacier National Park** will leave you breathless with its Alpine beauty. Then by special mini bus we travel the spectacular "**Going to the Sun Highway**", acclaimed as one of the most outstanding scenic roadways in the world. The 52 mile route traverses through Logan Pass that affords magnificent views of many glaciers. This afternoon we board the cruise launch for a narrated tour of **Waterton National Park**. After a day long remembered we check into the Bayshore Inn in Waterton Lakes.



## Day 3 Thursday, September 9 Waterton Lakes - Banff

Our day begins by traveling the majestic beauty of **BANFF NATIONAL PARK**, Canada's oldest park. Here we enjoy an included lunch at the world-renowned **CHATEAU LAKE LOUISE - The Fairmont**, a palatial hotel overlooking the emerald waters of **LAKE LOUISE** and **VICTORIA Glacier**.



Next we come to enchanting **Moraine Lake** and the **Valley of Ten Peaks**. Crossing the **Continental Divide**, we enter Kicking Horse Pass and view the Spiral Tunnel - a pioneer railroad engineering feat. Following a visit to **Bow Falls** we check into our hotel, the Red Carpet Inn for a delightful two night stay.

## Day 4 Friday, September 10 Banff National Park - Jasper - Banff

Today we travel North America's most scenic drive - the **Columbia Icefield Parkway** to **JASPER**. Majestic mountains along with its variety of lakes make up the characteristics of **JASPER NATIONAL PARK** that contains 4,200 square miles of breathtaking beauty. Today's highlights also include **ATHABASCA FALLS**, known as a wildlife sanctuary. Heading back to our hotel we stop at **Sunwapta Falls** and beautiful **PEYTO LAKE**, a photographer's haven. (*Sleep Well*).



## Day 5 Saturday, September 11 Banff - Whitefish, Montana

More spectacular beauty awaits as we travel to **Golden**, the confluence of the **Columbia** and **Kicking Horse Rivers** and then on to **Invermere** where hang gliders are often seen launching off **Mount Swansea**. More breathtaking scenery lies ahead as we travel along the Columbia and Kootenay Rivers to Cranbrook. Crossing into Montana we arrive back at our hotel in Whitefish, the Holiday Inn, where this evening we enjoy cocktails and socializing with our traveling family.



## Days 6-7 Sunday & Monday Sept. 12-13 Whitefish - Home

All aboard Amtrak for our relaxing journey home. Departing Whitefish, Montana at 7:45 a.m. we arrive in St. Cloud at 5:14 a.m. on Monday, September 13, with new friendships and fond memories of the **Canadian Rockies**.

Sleeper accommodations on board Amtrak are available at an additional cost. All meals are included to passengers occupying a sleeper. Anyone interested in sleeper accommodations is encouraged to make your reservations A.S.A.P. as sleepers are limited. **Passport is required.**

### TO RESERVE A SPACE

### DEPARTURE POINT
