Day 1 • Saturday, July 9, 2011

MPLS - VANCOUVER, B.C.

Day 5 • Wednesday, July 13, 2011

Marvel at ancient, glacier-carved valleys, braided rivers and monumental mountain ranges as you travel the historic Alaska-Canada Highway on your way to Canada's westernmost settlement. Day 6 • Thursday, July 14, 2011

BEAVER CREEK/FAIRBANKS

Day 10 • Monday, July 18, 2011

ANCHORAGE

Following a visit to the Begich-Boggs Visitor Center, you board the mv Ptarmigan and cruise across iceberg strewn Portage Lake, coming within 300 yards of the face of Portage Glacier, making for a day long remembered.

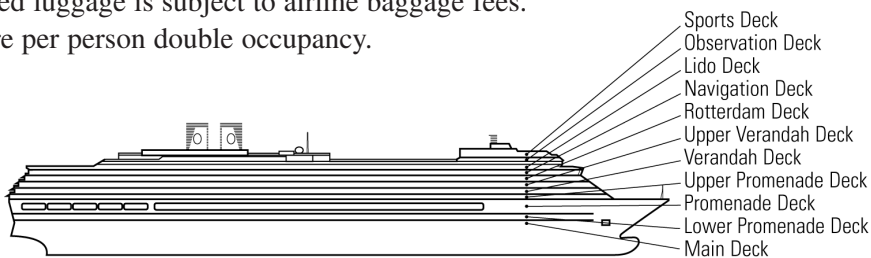
